Frequently Asked Questions – about age and gender

1. Does no restriction mean; no restrictions on number of males in team, no restriction on how many males can take the court at any one time and no restrictions on playing positions?
Yes this is correct. Refer Pg 7 – Q & A – Netball Victoria Gender Regulation - Mixed Gender
2. 11/U – no restrictions – Association cannot limit number of males playing in any one team in this age section.
Yes this is correct. Refer Pg 7 – Q & A – Netball Victoria Gender Regulation - Mixed Gender
3. Does this mean that a team could enter with as many males as they wish and could enter as an all male team?
Yes this is correct. Refer Pg 7 – Q & A – Netball Victoria Gender Regulation - Mixed Gender
4. Does this also mean that 11/U Females players must play against males if a team registers with male players, ie; have no option to choose the gender of competition that they play in.
Yes this is correct. Refer Pg 7 – Q & A – Netball Victoria Gender Regulation - Mixed Gender.
The Equal Opportunity Act prohibits the discrimination of children under the age of 12.
5. Associations can offer 13/U Mixed where all female teams may register to play.
13/U Mixed, Association cannot limit number of males playing in any one team in this age section. Therefore could have all 7 males.
Yes this is correct. Refer Pg 7 – Q & A – Netball Victoria Gender Regulation - Mixed Gender
6. Can Associations offer a 13/U (Female) competition where by number of male participants in any one team may be defined. ie 1, 2 or 3..... restricted to participate if clearly stated in KDNA By-laws and meets NV Gender Regulations with age requirements - Male is 12 years of age at the start of the competition or turning 13 during the season as this supports NV Gender regulations with the intentions to facilitate participation by girls and is reasonable.
No – there are no restrictions for males that play that are <13 years of age at the start of competition / season.

Associations cannot override the Regulation in the bylaws.
