## CONTEXT

Kingston & Districts Netball Association (KDNA) is located at Dale's Park, 570 Warrigal Rd, Oakleigh South. Dales Park was bequeathed to the City of Kingston Council for the sole purpose of use in women's sport. KDNA has honoured this legacy with playing netball at this facility. KDNA was born in December 1999 as an amalgamation of two associations; Cheltenham Heights Netball Association and Moorabbin Netball Association.

## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

- To encourage and promote netball and to ensure that Netball is played within the best possible facilities and environment in the local and broader community.
- To organise and conduct inter Club and inter Association matches.
- To control inter Club and inter Association matches played at sporting facilities owner, leased or managed by KDNA.

- To encourage improvement in the standard of Netball and sportsmanship generally.
- To manage and ensure financial viability and accountability.
- To Affiliate with the Victorian Netball Association Inc.

## GRASSROOTS PROGRAMS

Two domestic competition are held annually; Autumn and Spring with 11&U, 13&U, 15&U 17&U and Open age sections.

## REPRESENTATING TEAMS








A representative program for all age sections compete in inter Association competition. 11/U13/U, 15/, 17U and Open teams participate in the Waverley Netball night Competition. This provides a pathway to regional and state levels for players.

KDNA host its Annual Association Representative Tournament usually held in July.

Majority of Players come from within a radius of the Dingley, Aspendale, Brighton, to Caulfield area, covering many suburbs and communities.

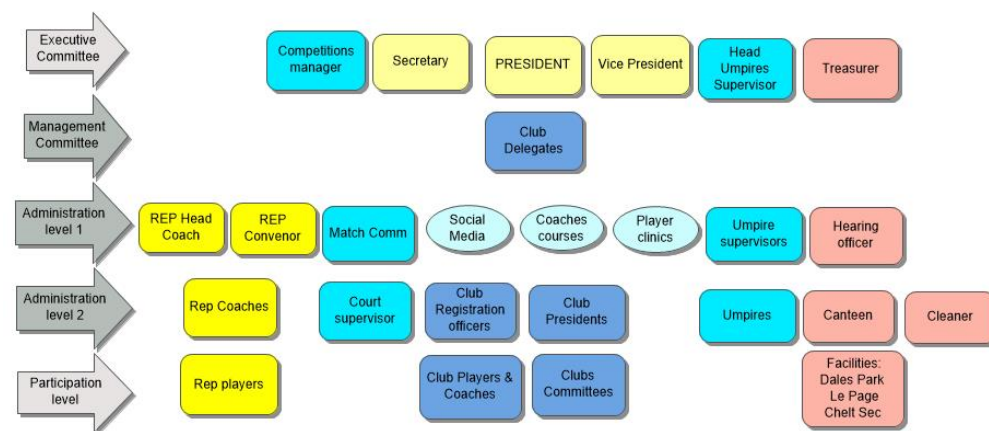
